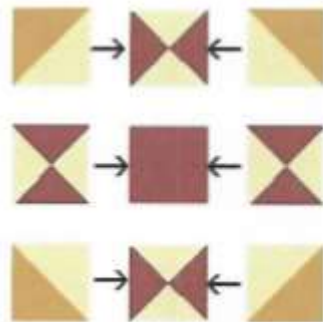

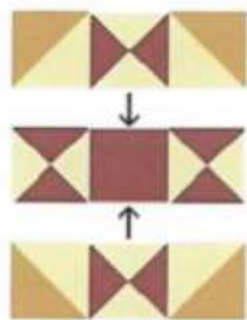
Part 4 - A Star is Born

Sewing Instructions:

Step 1: Assemble four quarter square triangles, four B/C half-square triangles and one Color A 4-1/2" square and arrange according to the diagram below. Sew into horizontal rows as shown.



Step 2: Sew rows together to form the block. One star block made.



Sew rows together

=



Make 1

Square to 12-1/2"

SUSPECT "B"

Step 3: Assemble four quarter square triangles, three D/C half-square triangles, one B/C half-square triangle, and one Color A 4-1/2" square and arrange according to the diagram below. Sew into horizontal rows as shown. Repeat three more times, for a total of four copies of each of the three rows.
