## CLUE 2: Use Evidence Bag #2:

Use 18 background squares cut at 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"  
9 background squares cut at 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"  
9 **Coordinate A** squares cut at 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"  
9 **Coordinate B** rectangles, cut at cut at 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"

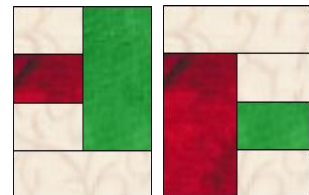
- Sew 2 background squares to the opposite sides of each **Coordinate A** square. Press seam allowance in the same direction. Make 9 sets.
- Sew a **Coordinate B** rectangle to each strip. Press toward the coordinate rectangle.
- Sew one background rectangle to each unit as shown. Make sure the coordinate B is on the left and the background rectangle is on the top. Press toward the background rectangle.
- This is **Suspect B**. Assemble 9 Suspect B's.

## CLUE 3:

- Gather one *Suspect A* and one *Suspect B*. Assemble as shown.
- Make sure that Suspect A is on the left and Suspect B is on the right.
- Press in the same direction.
- This is your **Prime Suspect #1**. Make 9
